Heating or cooling of the cottage

In the cottage there is air conditioning, you can set heating and cooling with the remote control. If it is really cold, you can also switch on the heating elements and adjust the heat with its thermostat. In the toilet / shower room there is underfloor heating, the thermostat is on the wall. Ventilation in the shower room starts automatically.

Cleaning of the cottage

The cottage must be in good condition after your stay.

At the end of your stay you need to take care of the following things:

- o Clean away rubbish and bottles. The dustbin is behind the cabins
- Vacuum and dry floors, wipe tables and shelves
- o Wash dishes and put pots, plates, glasses and cutlery back in place.
- Clean toilet and shower room
- o Make sure that the terrace and jetty are free of debris
- Put goods and furniture in place
- o Take the parasol inside after your visit
- o If you have used the grill, clean the grill grate

When you check out of the cottage

Put the key back in the key cabinet when you check out.

When you leave the cottage during your stay

Remember to take your key with you when you leave the cottage during your stay.

Common sense and etiquette

You may:

- Move outdoors on foot, on skis or by bicycle except in courtyards and areas taken into special use (for example, cultivated fields and plantations)
- Temporarily stay in places where it is also otherwise allowed to move (for example, camping at a sufficient distance from the nearest buildings)
- o Pick wild berries, mushrooms and flowers
- o Travel in streams and on ice

You may not:

- o Disturb or cause inconvenience or injury to other people or nature
- o Disturb wildlife and birds' nesting
- Felling or damaging trees
- o Take mosses, lichens, soil material or trees
- Disturb home peace
- o Litter
- o Drive motor vehicles in terrain without the permission of the landowner
- o Fishing and hunting without proper permission
